Bouldering wall	Injury	- To be used only under adult supervision. - Regular checks of the holds and rubber floor matting.
Archery range / archery store *	Injury or death	Site specific risk assessment available in archery store
Orienteering	Slips Trips Falls	Aware of natural environment
Pioneering equipment	Injury – manual handling Splinters Slips/trips/falls	Users should have their own risk assessment for the activity Annual inspection of timbers Report damaged equipment
Fires	Injury - Burns Fire spreading	Follow site rules – should be raised off the ground and in designated areas only. Keep designated fire areas clear. Report any concerns.
Frisbee golf equipment	Injury – damaged equipment	Users should have their own risk assessment for the activity

		Equipment regularly inspected and maintained Tee off and target areas maintained Report damaged equipment
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*Archery range to be operated and run by permitted leaders or by prior arrangement with Ratlingate. The range should be run in accordance with the permit holders' site-specific Risk Assessment. Ratlingate has a range specific Risk Assessment in place.
